# DINOSAURS, RAINDROPS, AND MOON ROCKS



Explore the wonders of **Dinosaur Ridge, Fossil Trace,** and the **Colorado School of Mines (CSM) Geology Museum** in Golden on a day of discovery with trip leader and geologist, Pete Varney. This fall tour will show participants the tracks and impressions of both flora and fauna from Jurassic and Cretaceous times. We will have lunch in Golden followed by a trip to the fabulous mineral museum at the Colorado School of Mines where the newly recovered moon rocks are on exhibit.

This Saturday trip on October 23rd is open to members, guests and interested, well-behaved children over the age of 12. Participants should meet at the Friends of Dinosaur Ridge location at Alameda and Rooney Road by 9:45am to catch the guided bus tour followed by a visit to the museum. The tour will last about an hour and a half. From there, we will carpool to Fossil Trace off 6<sup>th</sup> Ave in Golden.
